Monohybrid cross

Monohybrid inheritance is the inheritance of a single character i.e. plant height. It involves the inheritance of two alleles of a single gene. When the F1 generation was selfed Mendel noticed that 787 of 1064 F2 plants were tall, while 277 of 1064 were dwarf. The dwarf trait disappeared in the F1 generation only to reappear in the F2 generation. The term genotype is the genetic constitution of an individual. The term phenotype refers to the observable characteristic of an organism.
